



DELFIN I - AMAZON CRUISE 4 NIGHT SAMPLE ITINERARY

Day 1

On arrival at Iquitos airport, you will be met by a Delfin representative. From here, the journey starts towards Nauta, a small riverside town on the banks of the Marañón River. Once there, you are welcomed at the private port. When boarding, enjoy a fantastic panoramic view from the observation area. Participate in an orientation talk and get to know the entertainment centre that offers movies, as well as an extensive library of books about flora and fauna of the area. Dinner on board this evening.

Day 2

Wake up early to appreciate one of the most beautiful areas of the Pacaya Samiria National Reserve: Fundo Casual. The walk through this area will take you to the depths of the Terra Firme jungle (un-flooded forest) where you can appreciate the local fauna. Return to the boat for lunch on board. After lunch, visit Nauta Caño where you have the opportunity to kayak or go fishing for the famous piranha. Return to the boat where dinner is served.

Day 3

During the morning, take a walk through the canopy of the Amazon Park, a unique experience in the jungle! At the height of more than 25 meters and a length of 500 meters, the "Canopy Walkway" offers a view from the top of the trees, the best observation point to admire the jungle's wildlife and vegetation. After lunch on board, cross through the Yanayacu and Pucate rivers, passing through different streams and lagoons. This is one of the best preserved and protected areas of the Pacaya Samiria National Reserve. If you want to interact directly with the waters of the Amazon, go out in one of the kayaks or paddle boards; and you will even have the opportunity to swim with the curious pink dolphins. Return to the boat and enjoy dinner on board.

Day 4

After breakfast, visit a local community to meet the people who have inhabited the Amazon for generations. During the visit, the villagers share their traditions and customs with visitors. Return to the boat for lunch. Later enjoy a boat exploration of the Yarapa River, a tributary of the Ucayali River and a nature reserve protected by a local community. Farewell dinner this evening.

Day 5

During the morning disembark in the port of Nauta and head towards the airport. On the way, visit the Floating Mammals Rescue and Rehabilitation Centre to learn about manatees and other rescued species, as well as plans for the species conservation. On arrival at the airport, you will be accompanied by a representative who will assist you with departure formalities.
